PILECH-NIN-HER-STA

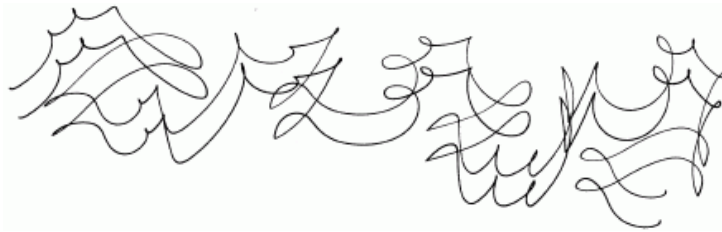


Source is the all-encompassing Presence flowing through All That Is. When you connect with this Source, you automatically tap into life-force and power.

18. Playful Adventure

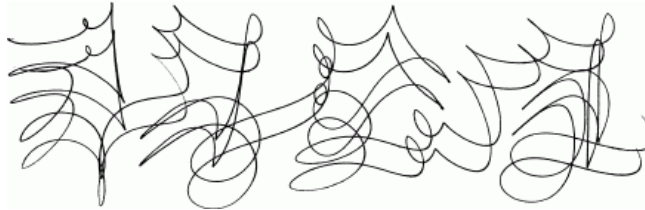
U-E-NEN-HIRSA
